

Student Code of Conduct

The St. Mary's School Student Dress Code Requirements are developed by a committee of teachers, parents, students and the principal. St. Mary's School believes the use of Dress Code Requirements promotes respect for self and one another, eases the strain on parental budgets, lessens socioeconomic differences and encourages students to concentrate on learning rather than on what they are wearing.

- Students will come to school ready to start the day dressed in proper attire.
- Students will respect the dress code policy and serve as examples to one another.
- Students understand there are disciplinary actions for dress code violations.

Violation Consequences

The Student Dress Code Policy will be enforced by teachers and the Principal.

1st violation: Sit out next recess. Dress Code Policy sent home to family highlighting violation.

2nd violation: Additional missed recesses. Form sent home requiring parent & student signature.

3rd violation: Additional missed recesses. Cannot participate in next Casual Dress Day. Form sent home requiring parent and student signature.

All disciplinary actions are at the discretion of the teacher and/or Principal

Student's Overall Appearance

Girl's Mass Dress: White blouse, button-down shirt; skirt, skort or jumper only. No shorts or pants.

Boy's Mass Dress: White, button-down dress shirt. A tie. Pants—no shorts allowed. A dress belt (grades 2-8). *Mass is every Friday as well as some Holy days throughout the year.*

General

- Clothing must be clean, hemmed and free of holes
- No oversize, baggy, low-rise or full elastic waistband pants. No outside-sewn labels visible
- Under garments must not be visible
- Shirts are to be tucked in at all times
- Girls blouses must be plain with no trim, ruffle or lace.
- **No sweatshirts or sweaters other than noted in uniform section are allowed in the classroom**
- Pants are to be no longer than the top of the foot
- Skirts/skorts/jumpers/shorts no shorter than 3" above the knee
- Hair must be clean, neat and trimmed
- Hats and caps are not allowed inside the building
- No open-toe or open-heeled shoes. No cleats or excessive platform or heeled shoes. Boots allowed only for rain or snow. **Tennis shoes MUST be worn on P.E. days**
- Stud earrings only. No more than 1 piercing in lower lobe. No other body piercing
- Watches, rings and chains with religious medals or crosses are allowed. No other jewelry is allowed
- K-6 students MAY NOT wear nail polish
- 7-8 students are allowed a minimal amount of make-up. Nail polish pastel pinks and white only
- Spirit shirts allowed on Mondays only
